

On Thursday, April 20, 1995, representatives of QVC, Inc. met with Jill Lockett, Special Advisor to Commissioner Chong, in connection with the above-captioned proceeding. Representing QVC, Inc. were Sue Blumenfeld and the undersigned. We discussed the Commission's rule requiring cable operators to offset revenues received from a home shopping channel against the \$.20 network cost adjustment when adding a home shopping channel to a regulated tier under the Commission's new "going-forward" rules.
