A second Joint Request for Extension of Time was filed on April 20, 1995, wherein the applicant parties seek additional time to file a Reply pleading to the Bureau's Comments wherein the Bureau opposes Settlement unless the applicants modify a provision in their agreement which seeks to prohibit either party from opposing any grant of any application to the other party for a period of ten years.

Cause has been stated for the requested additional time until April 28, 1995, in order for the parties to address that important issue. The applicants represent that the Bureau has been contacted and that the Bureau does not interpose any objection to the second requested extension.

Accordingly, IT IS ORDERED that the second Joint Request for Extension of Time filed on April 20, 1995, IS GRANTED.¹

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the time for filing a Reply pleading to the Bureau's Comments IS EXTENDED to April 28, 1995.
