Under consideration is the Report on Status of Preparation and Filing of Settlement Documents and Pleadings and Request for an Additional Thirty Days Suspension of Procedural Dates, filed by Telephone and Data Systems, Inc. (TDS), United States Cellular Corporation (USCC), the Wisconsin 8 Settlement Group (the Settlement Group)¹, BellSouth Mobility, Inc. (BellSouth) and the Wireless Telecommunications Bureau (the Bureau), filed on May 17, 1995.

Petitioners seek a further extension of all procedural dates established in this proceeding in order to provide the Parties with sufficient time to submit various pleadings which, if favorably acted upon, would resolve the issues in this proceeding without the need for a hearing. The Presiding Judge finds good cause for granting the relief sought, and the Parties will have an additional thirty days within which to file the various pleadings identified in the above referenced pleading.

IT IS ORDERED, that the extension request set forth in the Report on Status of Preparation and Filing of Settlement Documents and Pleadings and Request for an Additional Thirty Day Suspension of Procedural Dates, filed by Telephone and Data Systems, Inc., United States Cellular Corporation, the Wisconsin 8 Settlement Group, BellSouth Mobility Inc., and the Wireless

Telecommunications Bureau, on May 17, 1955, IS GRANTED, and the Parties will have until June 19, 1995, in which to file the pleadings identified in the aforementioned status report.
