On behalf of McCaw Cellular Communications, Inc. ("McCaw"), this letter (two copies of which are being submitted) notifies the Commission that, on May 26, 1995, Cathleen A. Massey, Guillermo Belt, and the undersigned met with Stephen J. Markendorff, Barnett C. ("Jay") Jackson, Jr., and Shahnaz K. Ghavami of the Wireless Telecommunications Bureau concerning McCaw's Petition for Reconsideration ("Petition") of the Third Report and Order in GN Docket No. 93-252, PR Docket No. 93-144, and PR Docket No. 89-553, FCC 94-212 (September 23, 1994). Specifically, the McCaw representatives discussed with the Commission staff McCaw's proposal that the Commission delete from Form 600 the information requested by item C21, Distance to CGSA, for each of the cell site radials. McCaw reiterated its concerns, expressed in the Petition, that the requested information would not be or remain accurate at the same time that it is very burdensome for licensees to calculate. As an alternative to deleting the C21 column, McCaw presented the possibility of replacing the listing of specific values for the distance to the CGSA with a notification as to whether the CGSA along that radial falls outside the applicant's licensed market. If so, the applicant also would indicate whether the distance to the CGSA boundary is equal to or less than the distance to the service area boundary. McCaw believes that including such a question in lieu of the current item C21 data would provide the Commission with desired information that a

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situation may require further review without imposing on licensees the same substantial burden associated with the current form information requirements.
