CONSENT MOTION FOR POSTPONEMENT OF HEARING

Herbert L. Schoenbohm, by his attorney, hereby respectfully requests the Administrative Law Judge to postpone the hearing in this proceeding from June 13, 1995, to August 8, 1995. In support thereof, it is alleged:

1. The ALJ has just issued an order, adding new issues against Mr. Schoenbohm, pertaining to the Commission's ex parte rules. Mr. Schoenbohm is not prepared to go forward under these new issues at this time. He needs additional time to prepare his exhibits. Moreover, Mr. Schoenbohm lacks the financial resources

to come to Washington twice, once for a hearing on the existing issues, and again for the hearing on the new issues.

2. The ends of justice would be served by postponing the hearing, so that all the issues can be heard in one consolidated proceeding. This will not only serve the interests of Mr. Schoenbohm; it will also conserve the time and resources of the government, by avoiding repetitive hearings.

3. A postponement until August 8, 1995, is respectfully requested. Counsel for the Wireless Telecommunications Bureau has graciously consented to the postponement.


