This is to clarify a matter stated in my letter to you of March 30, 1995 in the above-referenced matter. This relates to that portion of the letter relative to records from "Club Infinity".

My client, Ms. M. Janet Washington, President, Praise Media, Inc., reports that her copies of records maintained by her relative to "Club Infinity" had been stolen from the place where they had been kept--within the studio building of station KARW. As a result, those records are not available to be produced to you.

Ms. Washington clarified that, when she and I had spoken shortly prior to the March 30 document production, she was referring to a contact she had made with the Longview, Texas office of the Texas Office of the Comptroller to secure its help in reconstructing records as to cash receipts. According to Ms. Washington, a Mr. Stephens of that office, telephone 903-236-7797, indicated that his office did have some records relative to "Club Infinity"; Ms. Washington reported to the undersigned this date that she has made a request to the Texas Office of the Comptroller to obtain copies such records as are maintained by it; however, she has been told that copies of
