This is to advise you that Ameritech Operating Companies and Bell Atlantic Telephone Companies, on April 28, 1995 and May 2, 1995, filed Section 402(a) Petition for Review of: In the Matter of Price Cap Regulation of Local Exchange Carriers, FCC 95-133, released April 14, 1995.

Petitioners challenge FCC order amending price cap rules to include an express requirement that telephone companies make an "add-back" adjustment when calculating earnings for purposes of determining "sharing" obligations and low-end adjustments.

Due to a change in the Communications Act, it will not be necessary to notify the parties of this filing.

The Court has docketed these cases as No. 95-1239 and 95-1245 and the attorney assigned to handle the litigation is Laurence N. Bourne.
