You are hereby advised by an original and one copy that today ex parte oral presentations were made in the above referenced proceeding to: Mass Media Bureau personnel Robert Greenberg, Sharon Bertelsen and Robert Hayne; Wireless Telecommunications Bureau personnel Roger Noel, Albert S. Briggs and Stephen Markendorff; and Compliance and Information Bureau personnel Jeffrey B. Young and James G. Voight by Edward W. Hummers, Jr. on behalf of Nationwide Communications Inc. and Donald G. Everist, Robert D. Culver and Alan R. Rosner on behalf of the Association of Federal Communications Consulting Engineers.

The presentations were a discussion of (1) the need for a distinction between the processing of existing structures *vis a vis* new structures; (2) the necessity to define, with specificity, the parameters for establishing (a) "insignificant" deviations in tower coordinates, height and elevation which would be "grandfathered" and the methods of reporting such deviations and (b) "significant" deviations which would not be "grandfathered" and would require applications and Commission approval; (3) the significance and potential impact of Federal Aviation Administration policies and procedures; (4) methods of determining tower location and (5) the potential impact of processing deviations on the internal processes of the Commission.


