MOTION FOR ABEYANCE PENDING RECONSIDERATION

Respondent, Florida Power & Light Company, moves for abeyance of the above matter pending reconsideration by the Common Carrier Bureau, and in support therefor states:

1. Florida Power & Light Company has Petitioned the Common Carrier Bureau for Clarification and Reconsideration of its Hearing Designation Order in the above matter, released June 15, 1995. A copy of that Petition is attached hereto.

2. FPL is uncertain exactly what the Administrative Judge is to decide in that all substantive issues were addressed by the Bureau and has asked for clarification on the issues to be determined by the Administrative Law Judge.

3. Moreover, FPL has requested reconsideration of the Hearing Designation Order on the substantive issue of FPL's use of subaccount 369.1, in that, there is no record evidence (or discussion) to support the Bureau's statements and all evidence supports the position of FPL that use of such account should be allowed.

4. Until the Common Carrier Bureau rules on FPL's Petition for Clarification and Reconsideration, the issues to be decided by the Administrative Law Judge remain uncertain.


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
