Pursuant to Section 1.1206(a) of the Commission's Rules, this is to notify you that Jeffrey Sheldon, representing UTC, The Telecommunications Association (UTC) met yesterday afternoon with Ralph Haller, Laurence Atlas, and Robert McNamara, of the Wireless Telecommunications Bureau concerning some of the issues raised in various comments and reply comments filed in response to the petition for rulemaking of Pacific Bell Mobile Services regarding a cost-sharing plan for microwave relocation (RM-8643). UTC summarized some of the points raised in UTC's Comments and Reply Comments in this proceeding. UTC noted that it would be counterproductive for the Commission to use this proceeding as an opportunity to revisit all of the carefully-balanced relocation policies adopted in ET Docket No. 92-9, and that the allegations of abuse cited by some of the commenters are largely unsupported or speculative, particularly given the fact that the voluntary negotiation period commenced just recently. UTC further noted that contrary to these allegations, PCS licensees and incumbent microwave licensees are successfully concluding relocation agreements.
