Pursuant to Section 1.1206(a) of the Commission's Rules, this is to notify you that William Chapman, President of UTC, The Telecommunications Association (UTC), and Jeffrey Sheldon, General Counsel for UTC, met on July 10 with the staff of the Wireless Telecommunications Bureau regarding some of the issues in the above-referenced proceeding on the "refarming" of the Private Land Mobile Radio bands.

The parties discussed the proposed consolidation of radio services as well as some of the technical issues that would have to be addressed before competitive frequency coordination could be fully implemented. UTC also discussed the proposals in the *Further Notice of Proposed Rulemaking* to allow permissive resale of excess capacity and to use competitive bidding with no eligibility restrictions, noting that adoption of these proposals could lead to the conversion of the private land mobile radio bands into commercial mobile radio services, with no spectrum retained to meet the internal communications needs of many critical users, including utilities and pipelines.
