I feel very strongly that the FCC should give serious consideration to Apple's petition for an NII band in order to allocate spectrum in the 5 GHz band - to establish a wireless component of the National Information Infrastructure. I believe it is critical that the public be assured of access to a technology that can all too easily be monopolized and controlled.

I realize that the issue is becoming increasingly complex with competing interests only making the situation seem more overwhelming. In the race for bandwidth, it is absolutely essential that public access be a priority.
