F. Backup D-Channel (BD-C) - Allows, in certain central offices, enhanced survivability of SmartTrunk links by providing automatic takeover for a failed D-Channel.

G. Calling Line Identification (CLID) - Allows the number of the calling party to be delivered to the called party.

3.4 Standards Compliance

SmartTrunk Service is designed to all relevant International Telephone and Telegraph Consultative Committee (CCITT) and Bellcore standards.

3.5 Technical Specifications

Network Interface Requirements for ISDN customer access are described in detail in TR-TSY-000776 (Network Interface Description for ISDN Customer Access).

3.6 Regulations

A. The following regulations apply in addition to other regulations stated in this and the other tariffs of the Company. For the purposes of this service, where such other regulations apply on a "per line" basis, they shall be interpreted, in this instance, to apply on a "per channel" basis.

(CP) B. SmartTrunk Service is offered only for use with compatibly equipped FCC Part 68 registered FXS equipment. The customer will be required to select a service term for the SmartTrunk Interface consisting of 36 or 60 continuous months. Customers selecting the 36 month service term may opt to convert to the 60 month term prior to the expiration of the 36 month term. All service components, except the SmartTrunk Interface, have a minimum service term of one month.

C. SmartTrunk Service is not offered on a stand-alone basis.

D. Other ancillary tariff offerings requested by the customer and not incompatible with nor detrimental to this offering, may be furnished in accordance with the regulations and at the rates and charges specified in the applicable section of this tariff or other tariffs of the Company. Should such ancillary services normally be applied on a "per line" basis, they will, in this instance, apply on a "per channel" basis.

2. The central office switching equipment (trunk termination) portion of PBX-DID Service is not applicable for DID local exchange service associated with this offering, therefore not chargeable.

E. In addition to the rates and charges contained in this tariff, the customer is responsible for the payment of all related charges for exchange services, miscellaneous and supplemental service as specified in this and other tariffs of the Company.

F. Unique requests for special or modified service arrangements will be accepted, whenever possible, if not detrimental to this or other services of the Company. Such requests will be based upon cost.

G. SmartTrunk Service is furnished as stated in Section 25, Paragraph 25.5.1, of the General Exchange Tariff and is subject to all of the rules and regulations therein.

H. In certain central offices, the additional services of Intrastate, IntraLATA Foreign Exchange (FX) service, Foreign Serving Office (FSO) service and TIE service may be associated with SmartTrunk Service. However, Dynamic Channel Allocation will not be offered for these services.

K. If a customer requests SmartTrunk Service to be provisioned from an office other than the SmartTrunk serving office designated by the Telephone Company, and if agreed to by the Company, the charges specified in this Tariff are applicable in addition to the rates, charges, terms and conditions of FSO/FX Service pursuant to the "Foreign Exchange Service" and "Foreign Serving Office Service" sections of the General Exchange Tariff.

3.9 Supersedure

SmartTrunk Service may be transferred to a new customer at the same premises location upon written concurrence of the Telephone Company. The customer to whom service is transferred will be subject to all past indebtedness, liabilities, minimum term provision and equipment configurations currently in effect for the previous customer. A Service Connection Charge, as specified in Section 25, Paragraph 25.9.1 of the General Exchange Tariff, will be applicable.

3.10 Suspension of Service Initiated By The Customer

Temporary suspension of service initiated by the customer, as provided in Section 35 of the General Exchange Tariff, is not applicable to service furnished under the provisions of this tariff.

3.11 Options Available Upon Expiration of the Service Term

Upon the expiration of the service term, the customer may:

1. Continue service without establishing a new service term. The SmartTrunk Interface will be provided on a month-to-month basis at the then current 60-month service term rate, with no additional service commitment. However, this rate will be subject to Company initiated rate changes when approved by the Arkansas Public Service Commission.
2. Continue service by selecting a new service term, of 36 or 60 months, for the SmartTrunk Interface at the then current rate. The new service term will commence on the day following the expiration of the previous service term. The rate will not be subject to Company initiated rate increases for the duration of the service term.

3.12 Rate and Charge Applications

- A. Recurring, installation, and nonrecurring charges are applicable according to the specific schedule for the service quoted under this plan.
- B. The monthly rate applicable at the time a customer subscribes or elects an additional service term for the SmartTrunk Interface under this plan, is not subject to Company initiated increases during the life of the service term.

(CT) C. Installation and special construction charges for SmartTrunk service are normally paid in full at the time of installation. When requested by the customer prior to installation, these charges may be deferred and satisfied by making a series of consecutive monthly payments. The installation and/or special construction charge may be deferred over a payment period of 12, 24, 36, 48 or 60 months, not to exceed the service term selected. Once a deferred charge payment period is selected, it will remain in effect for the duration of the period.

(CT) D. To compute the value of the monthly deferred charge payment, the installation and/or special construction charge is multiplied by the following annuity factor for the appropriate term. A charge equal to the sum of the remaining payments will be due immediately should the service be terminated early.

- F. If the customer cancels an order for service after installation of the required equipment and facilities, but before service is established, the customer agrees to pay a charge equaling the sum of monthly payments remaining on the service term as if the service had actually been established. The customer may not avoid this provision by simply extending their acceptance of the service date.
- G. If the customer cancels an order for service before installation of the required equipment and facilities is completed, the customer agrees to pay all expenses incurred in connection with the handling of the request before notice of cancellation is received by the Telephone Company. This charge, shall not exceed all charges which would have been applicable if the service had been installed.
- H. Where Dynamic Channel Allocation is not being provided, each service shall be billed at the appropriate recurring and nonrecurring charges in quantities as specified by the customer.
- I. Where Dynamic Channel Allocation is being provided for DID/DOD services, the following procedure shall be applied:
  - 1. Non-DID/DOD services shall be billed at the appropriate recurring and nonrecurring charges in quantities as specified by the customer.
  - 2. DID/DOD service arrangements involving a single local calling scope shall be billed based upon the appropriate recurring and nonrecurring charges and in quantities equal to the difference between non-DID/DOD assigned channels and the total channels specified by the customer.
  - 3. DID/DOD service arrangements involving mixed local calling scopes, must restrict Dynamic Channel Allocation to the DID/DOD services having the smaller local calling scope. The DID/DOD service involving the larger local calling scope, shall be billed at the appropriate recurring and nonrecurring charges in quantities as specified by the customer. DID/DOD services involving the smaller local calling scope, shall be billed at the appropriate recurring and nonrecurring charges in quantities equal to the remaining available, but unassigned channels specified by the customer.

## SmartTrunk<sup>SM</sup> SERVICE

### 4.0 Descriptive Summary

SmartTrunk Service provides access to and from the Public Switched Telephone Network (PSTN) for circuit-switched voice (CSV) and circuit-switched data (CSD) communications. This communication capability is provided using Integrated Services Digital Network (ISDN) architecture and ISDN services available with SmartTrunk Service use Primary Rate Interface (PRI) technology. SmartTrunk Service employs a 1.544 Mbps facility typically divided into twenty-three B channels and one D channel. B channels are used for voice and data communications while the D channel provides out-of-band signaling.

### 4.1 General

All rates, charges, terms and conditions set forth herein provide for the furnishing of service where suitable facilities and equipment are available in the customer's serving office and do not create an obligation for the Company to construct such facilities or equipment especially for the provisioning of this service.

The prices for SmartTrunk Service may be changed in accordance with the Flexible Pricing Plan rules and regulations as specified in Section 20 of the General Exchange Tariff. Current prices are specified in the SmartTrunk Service Price List.

### 4.2 Service Components

- A. **SmartTrunk Interface (SI)** - Provides the PRI termination and a digital multichannel transmission path between the central office and the customer's premises.
- B. **Integrated Services Digital CSV/CSD Transport** - Provides for the local usage of the PSTN. Only Integrated Service Digital CSV/CSD Transport elements noted as "SmartTrunk Service Compatible" in Section 1 of this tariff can be associated with SmartTrunk Service.
- C. **Universal Termination** - Provides continuity between the SmartTrunk Interface and the PSTN using central office equipment for Foreign Exchange (FX), Foreign Serving Office (FSO) and Special Access services.
- D. **Dynamic Channel Allocation (DCA)** - Allows the user to dynamically allocate channels for Direct Outward Dial (DOD) and Direct Inward Dial (DID) services.

Network Interface Requirements for ISDN customer access are described in detail in TR-TSY-000776 (Network Interface Description for ISDN Customer Access).

### 4.5 Regulations

4.5.1 The following regulations apply in addition to other regulations stated in this and the other tariffs of the Company. For the purposes of this service, where such other regulations apply on a "per line" basis, they shall be interpreted, in this instance, to apply on a "per channel" basis.

4.5.2 SmartTrunk Service is offered only for use with compatibly equipped FCC Part 68 registered PBX equipment. The customer will be required to select a service term for the SmartTrunk Interface consisting of 36 or 60 continuous months. Customers subscribing to the 36 month service term may convert to the 60 month term, prior to the expiration of the 36 month term, without incurring termination charges as specified in paragraph 4.11 following. All service components, except the SmartTrunk Interface, have a minimum service term of one month.

4.5.3 SmartTrunk Service is not offered on a stand-alone basis.

- 4.5.4 Other ancillary tariff offerings requested by the customer and not incompatible with nor detrimental to this offering, may be furnished in accordance with the regulations and at the rates and charges specified in the applicable section of this tariff or other tariffs of the Company. Should such ancillary services normally be applied on a "per line" basis, they will, in this instance, apply on a "per channel" basis.
- A. Touch-Tone Calling Service is not applicable for DOD local exchange services associated with this offering, therefore not chargeable.
- B. The central office switching equipment (trunk termination) portion of PBX-DID Service is not applicable for DID local exchange service associated with this offering, therefore not chargeable.
- 4.5.5 In addition to the rates and charges contained in this tariff, the customer is responsible for the payment of all related charges for exchange services, miscellaneous and supplemental service as specified in this and other tariffs of the Company.
- 4.5.6 Unique requests for special or modified service arrangements will be accepted, whenever possible, if not detrimental to this or other services of the Company. Such requests will be based upon cost.
- 4.5.7 SmartTrunk Service is furnished as stated in Section 20, Paragraph 20.6.1, of the General Exchange Tariff and is subject to all of the rules and regulations therein.
- 4.5.8 In certain central offices, the additional services of Intrastate, IntraLATA Foreign Exchange (FX) service, Foreign Serving Office (FSO) service and Special Access service may be associated with SmartTrunk Service. However, Dynamic Channel Allocation will not be offered for these services.

- 4.5.9 Upon subscribing to SmartTrunk Service, the customer may be required to change telephone numbers.
- 4.5.10 The central office from which a customer's SmartTrunk Service is physically provisioned shall be designated the customer's SmartTrunk serving office. The Telephone Company will determine a customer's SmartTrunk serving office as follows:
- a. If the customer's normal serving office is SmartTrunk equipped, the customer will be provided SmartTrunk Service from their normal serving office.
  - b. If the customer's normal serving office is not SmartTrunk equipped, the customer may be provided SmartTrunk Service from another SmartTrunk equipped central office located within the customer's exchange at the rates and charges specified in this Tariff.
  - c. If the customer's exchange is not SmartTrunk equipped, the customer may be provided SmartTrunk Service from a SmartTrunk equipped central office located in a different exchange, if agreed to by the Telephone Company. In such cases, this Tariff is applicable in addition to the rates and charges for interoffice mileage as specified in Section 7 of the Access Tariff.
  - d. In cases 2 and 3 preceding, when the customer's normal serving office becomes SmartTrunk equipped, their SmartTrunk Service will continue to be provided from their original SmartTrunk serving office. Should the customer subsequently request that their SmartTrunk service be provisioned from their normal serving office, the provisions and charges specified in this Tariff for moves and disconnects will apply.
- 4.5.11 If a customer requests SmartTrunk Service to be provisioned from an office other than the SmartTrunk serving office designated by the Telephone Company, and if agreed to by the Telephone Company, the charges specified in this Tariff are applicable in addition to the rates, charges, terms and conditions of FSO/FX Service pursuant to the "Foreign Exchange Service" and "Foreign Serving Office Service" sections of the General Exchange Tariff.

4.5.12 Customer shall use Calling Line Identification (CLID) solely for the purposes of call processing, billing, and account management and shall not publicize or disclose any calling party number without written permission from the party to whom the telephone number has been assigned. By way of illustration, and not limitation, the customer shall not use any calling party number for telemarketing or list-generation efforts without written permission.

4.5.13 Note that special steps are required for PBX customers to have 911 service features consistent with those provided to other end users in the same 911 service area. Automatic Number Identification, Automatic Location Identification and/or Selective Routing are only available through coordination with the governmental agency responsible for 911 service within the area served by the PBX in accordance with the provisions of the Universal Emergency Number Service (911) section of the General Exchange Tariff.

4.6 Additions

Additions of service can be made by the payment of rates and charges in the then currently effective schedules for such service.

4.7 Moves

- (CP) 4.7.1 Service Connection charges as specified in the General Exchange Tariff and nonrecurring charges as specified in this tariff will apply when the SmartTrunk Interface is moved within the same SmartTrunk serving office or moved to a different SmartTrunk serving office.
- (CP) 4.7.2 The service term agreement subscribed to by the customer is not affected by moves of the SmartTrunk Interface as described in 4.7.1 above.

4.8 Supersedure

- (CT) SmartTrunk Service may be transferred to a new customer at the same premises location upon written concurrence of the Telephone Company. The customer to whom service is transferred will be subject to all past indebtedness, liabilities, minimum term provisions and equipment configurations currently in effect for the previous customer. A Service Connection charge, as specified in the Rules and Regulations Applying to All Customers' Contract section of the General Exchange Tariff, will be applicable.

4.9 Suspension of Service Initiated By The Customer

Temporary suspension of service initiated by the customer, as provided in the General Exchange Tariff, is not applicable to service furnished under the provisions of this tariff.

4.10 Options Available Upon Expiration of the Service Term

Upon the expiration of the service term, the customer may:

1. Continue service without establishing a new service term. The SmartTrunk Interface will be provided on a month-to-month basis at the then current 60-month service term rate, with no additional service commitment. However, this rate will be subject to Company initiated rate changes when approved by the Kansas Corporation Commission.
2. Continue service by selecting a new service term, of 36 or 60 months, for the SmartTrunk Interface at the then current rate. The new service term will commence on the day following the expiration of the previous service term. The new rate will not be subject to Company initiated rate increases for the duration of the service term.
3. Discontinue the service.

4.11 Rate and Charge Applications

4.11.1 Recurring, installation, and nonrecurring charges are applicable according to the specific schedule for the service quoted under this plan.

4.11.2 The monthly rate applicable at the time a customer subscribes or elects an additional service term for the SmartTrunk Interface under this plan, is not subject to Company initiated rate increases during the life of the service term.

(CP) 4.11.3 Installation charges for SmartTrunk Service are normally billed in full at the time of installation. Special construction charges are normally billed under one of the options detailed in the Construction Charges section of the General Exchange Tariff. Additional options are available for special construction charges and installation charges associated with SmartTrunk Service. When requested by the customer prior to installation, these charges may be paid by making a series of monthly payments over a specific payment period. SmartTrunk Service installation charges may be deferred over a payment period of 12, 24, 36, 48 or 60 months. For special construction charges, the customer may choose from the options detailed in the Construction Charges section of the General Exchange Tariff, or choose a payment period of 24, 36, 48 or 60 months. The payment period selected for the installation charges and/or special construction charges must not exceed the selected service term for the customer's SmartTrunk Interface.

(CP) To compute the value of the monthly deferred charge payment, the installation and/or special construction charge is multiplied by the annuity factor for the appropriate term. A charge equal to the sum of the remaining payments will be due immediately should the service be terminated early.

A table of annuity factors is listed in the Rules and Regulations Applying to All Customers' Contracts section of the General Exchange Tariff.

(CP) 4.11.4 In the event the SmartTrunk Service is disconnected prior to expiration of the service term, and the installation and/or special construction charge was deferred at the time service was established, the customer will be required to pay a charge equaling the sum of deferred payments remaining on the service term.

4.11.5 In the event that the SmartTrunk Interface is disconnected after the service is established, but prior to expiration of the service term, the customer will be required to pay a charge equaling the sum of monthly payments remaining on the service term for each SmartTrunk Interface disconnected.

- 4.11.6 If the customer cancels an order for service after installation of the required equipment and facilities, but before service is established, the customer agrees to pay a charge equaling the sum of monthly payments remaining on the service term as if the service had actually been established. The customer may not avoid this provision by simply extending their acceptance of the service date.
- 4.11.7 If the customer cancels an order for service before installation of the required equipment and facilities is completed, the customer agrees to pay all expenses incurred in connection with the handling of the request before notice of cancellation is received by the Telephone Company. This charge, however, shall not exceed all charges which would have been applicable if the service had been installed.
- 4.11.8 Where Dynamic Channel Allocation is not being provided, each service shall be billed at the appropriate recurring and nonrecurring charges in quantities as specified by the customer.
- 4.11.9 Where Dynamic Channel Allocation is being provided for DID/DOD services, the following procedure shall be applied:
- i. Non-DID/DOD services shall be billed at the appropriate recurring and nonrecurring charges in quantities as specified by the customer.
  - ii. DID/DOD service arrangements involving a single local calling scope shall be billed based upon the appropriate recurring and nonrecurring charges and in quantities equal to the difference between non-DID/DOD assigned channels and the total channels specified by the customer.

- iii. DID/DOD service arrangements involving mixed local calling scopes, must restrict Dynamic Channel Allocation to the DID/DOD services having the smaller local calling scope. The DID/DOD service involving the larger local calling scope, shall be billed at the appropriate recurring and nonrecurring charges in quantities as specified by the customer. DID/DOD services involving the smaller local calling scope, shall be billed at the appropriate recurring and nonrecurring charges in quantities equal to the remaining available, but unassigned channels specified by the customer.

4.11.10 OPTIONAL FEATURES

- A. LOOP PROTECTION: Provides automatic restoration of the SmartTrunk Interface facility and physical route redundancy from the customer's serving wire center to the point nearest the customer's premises that route redundancy can be achieved in the event of a transmission failure caused by a single facility break or a single loop electronics failure.

The automatic restoration capabilities are provided through the use of intelligent components which are capable of sensing transmission failures in the fiber facilities. The primary and secondary transmission paths are separately routed in geographically and physically separate fiber optic cables up to the nearest point to the customer's premises that route redundancy can be achieved. In the event of a transmission failure, the intelligent components will automatically switch the SmartTrunk Service from the primary to the secondary transmission path within 2.0 seconds.
