JOINT REPORT

In accordance with the Order of June 23, 1995, the following reports the present status of settlement discussions.

Bell South and the parties represented by Mr. Glist met to discuss settlement on July 6, 1995 and continued these discussions by telephone and/or fax on July 14, July 27, and July 28, 1995. Bell South and the party represented by Mr. Wimmer conferred by telephone July 14 and August 3. The remaining issues are:

1. What portion of Accounts 6535, 6124 and 6231, if any, should be factored into the carrying charges? For settlement purposes, respondent has offered to exclude Account 6231 and to include 50% of Account 6535 and 6124. Complainants have offered to include a fixed percentage of the disputed accounts if a second issue, described below, can also be resolved.

2. If these accounts are factored in, how should accumulated deferred taxes be accounted for in a modified formula? Complainants and Respondents have followed different methods, and there is an outstanding offer by complainants to split the difference.

There will remain the ministerial task of applying settlement or adjudicated rates against the amounts paid, computing the interest, and arranging for refunds. The parties are continuing to work towards settlement in an effort to avoid the need for further proceedings in this case.



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


