ORDER  
Issued: August 17, 1995 Released: August 21, 1995

Under consideration is a "Motion To Defer Briefing And Pre-Hearing Dates" filed August 16, 1995 by the Complainants and South Central Bell Telephone Company.

The Order of the Chief Administrative Law Judge released June 23, 1995 (FCC 95M-149) established specific pre-hearing procedures to simplify the process and to promote settlement. These interim steps included the filing by the parties of briefs in support of their positions by August 16, 1995 and the holding of a prehearing conference on August 21, 1995. The parties recite in their motion that they have reached settlement and urge that the noted procedural dates be deferred pending ruling on their settlement agreement. <sup>1</sup> The motion will be granted.

Accordingly, IT IS ORDERED, That the "Motion To Defer Briefing And Pre-Hearing Dates" filed August 16, 1995 IS GRANTED and the aforesaid procedural dates ARE CONTINUED WITHOUT DATE pending a ruling on the settlement agreement.
