


## Petition for Reconsideration

PR Docket No. 93-305

### I. INTRODUCTION

A number of organizations have (with family request) been trying to honor a deceased founder/member by perpetuating their call. This provides for the call to be associated with its history in contrast to the call being assigned to a stranger. (note 1)

### II. DISCUSSION

Gate one gives priority to family members of a deceased former call holder. In a number of cases no family member holds an Amateur License but they would like to see their deceased honored in perpetuity by an organization that the deceased started or was closely associated with.

It is therefore requested that gate One include club stations when a letter from the family requesting same is included and the deceased started and/or was clearly associated with the club associated organization. (note 2)

As this assignment is subservient to direct application by family members, it should be titled Gate 1a and take effect 31 days after March 24 i.e. on 24 April, 1995.

Once the vanity call sign provider passes the startup problems it will be a hardship to have trained workers waiting for the next gate, hence there will be pressure to provide an unbroken flow of 610-V applications. Gate 1a provides for an orderly flow.

### III. CONCLUSION

The FCC recognizes the great historic contribution made to radio communication by many Amateur Radio Licences. To honor their achievements and provide "historic landmarks" it gives priority to issuing their call signs to clubs that will honor the achiever. Clubs with family letters may apply for vanity calls in Gate One (a) starting on 24 April, 1995.

### IV. ORDERING CLAUSES


1. The FCC recognized call perpetuity as an honor when it issued W6AM.
2. The family of Bill Halligan (Hallicrafters founder) and Amateurs who worked for him and remained with the organization after its sale want to honor Bill with his call being used by the "William J. Halligan Memorial Radio Station", their Amateur club station.
