

On August 28, Chris Frentrup and I met with Karen Brinkman, Anthony Bush, Les Selzer and Steve Weingarten of the Common Carrier Bureau. The purpose of the meeting was to convey MCI's concerns over issues that could be addressed in the Further Notice of Proposed Rulemaking in this docket. Specifically, we questioned the need for additional price flexibility on the part of the price cap LECs. We also pointed out that the existing waiver process has protected customers and has not materially delayed significant new access services for MCI.
