**ORDER**

Adopted: October 10, 1995; Released: October 10, 1995

By the Chief, Tariff Division, Common Carrier Bureau:

1. On January 11, 1995, AT&T Corporation filed Transmittal No. CT 2592, which proposes to modify the price, volume discount, and availability sections of Contract Tariff No. 374. The Furst Group (TFG) and Public Service Enterprises, Inc. filed petitions to reject or suspend and investigate Transmittal No. CT 2952. On April 26, 1995, AT&T filed Transmittal No. CT 3441 to modify the revisions to Contract Tariff No. 374 proposed in its earlier transmittal. TFG also filed a petition to reject or suspend and investigate those modifications. On May 9, 1995, the Bureau suspended Transmittal Nos. CT 2952 and CT 3441 for five months and initiated an investigation.<sup>1</sup> These transmittals are scheduled to become effective November 10, 1995.

2. In this Order, we impose an accounting order on the rates proposed in Transmittal Nos. CT 2592 and CT 3441 in order to facilitate any refunds that may later prove necessary.

3. Accordingly, IT IS ORDERED that, pursuant to Section 204(a) of the Communications Act of 1934, as amended, 47 U.S.C. § 204(a), AT&T Corporation shall keep
