Pursuant to Section 1.1206(a)(2) of the Commission's Rules, this is to notify you that the undersigned, on behalf of UTC, The Telecommunications Association (UTC), met today with the staff of Commissioner Ness to discuss some of the outstanding issues in the Commission's proceeding to "refarm" the Private Land Mobile Radio spectrum below 512 MHz (PR Docket No. 92-235).

UTC summarized some of the points it raised in earlier Comments and Reply Comments filed in this docket. UTC also discussed the potential for consolidation of radio services, and the need to protect private radio spectrum relied upon by public service organizations, such as electric, gas and water utilities and natural gas pipelines, from potential depletion by commercial carriers.
