SUPPLEMENT TO  
FURTHER COMMENTS

On September 29, 1995, comments were made in this proceeding on behalf of Fresno Mobile Radio, Inc. *et al*, requesting that the Commission reject the Bureau's orally stated recommendations to the Commission that it auction access to a portion of the 800 MHz SMR radio spectrum, adopt rules which would demand frequency migration by incumbent licensees, limit the operational flexibility of non-wide area systems, and extinguish the reasonable business expectancies held by one class of persons for the express purpose of benefitting the competitive capability of another class of persons. Such acts being inappropriate, anticompetitive, without legal foundation, and contrary to the clear language of Section 309 of the Communications Act of 1934 (as amended), Fresno Mobile Radio, Inc. *et al* opposed the Bureau's stated recommendation and respectfully requested that the Commission reject the Bureau's Plan in favor of the existing rules.
