Dear Mr. Caton:

On November 29, 1995, representatives of a Cable Inside Wire coalition met with Lisa Smith, Legal Advisor to Commissioner Barrett. Coalition members include Bell Atlantic, GTE, SNET, NYNEX, SBC, USTA, Media Access Project, Liberty Cable, Video Dialtone Association and CFA. Coalition representatives at the meeting were Jay Newman-Liberty Cable/Video Dialtone Association, Gigi Sohn-Media Access Project, and the undersigned.

The purpose of the meeting was to discuss the need for the Commission to reconsider and change its current cable inside wire rules, particularly those applicable to multi-dwelling units to promote consumer choice and competition in the video distribution market. The coalition also encouraged the Commission to initiate a separate rule making proceeding to establish uniform rules concerning access to, and ownership of, inside wire used to provide similar services. The positions stated were consistent with the views previously expressed by the parties in their joint and individual filings in the above-captioned proceedings.
