

<sup>1/</sup> SALAD, which is Miami's principal Hispanic civil rights organization, filed a petition to deny the TBF application and participated in this case for the purpose of protecting the Commission's policies favoring minority media access and ownership. SALAD did not participate below in the adjudication of the issues designated against applicant Glendale Broadcasting Company, and consequently SALAD takes no position on the I.D.'s resolution of those issues. However, SALAD finds nothing in the I.D.'s resolution of the Glendale issues which would affect the Commission's minority media access and ownership policies one way or the other.


