On December 12, 1995, Ross Ruthenberg and Norm Alexander of Motorola and I met with Ira Keltz of the FCC's Wireless Telecommunications Bureau to discuss technical issues that are part of the above captioned proceeding. In particular, Motorola discussed the impact of the FCC's new rules relating to equivalent spectrum efficiency standards for data radios and frequency stability for 6.25 kHz radios. Motorola also reiterated its position on the measurement procedures adopted to ensure compliance with the FCC's emission mask requirements. These issues are before the FCC in petitions for reconsideration filed against the Second Report and Order in the above captioned proceeding.
