MOTION FOR EXTENSION OF TIME TO FILE REPLY COMMENTS

The Ad Hoc Alliance for Public Access to 911 ("Alliance"), hereby moves that the Commission extend the deadline for filing reply comments in this matter from January 3, 1996, to a date that is three weeks following the reopening of the Commission following the budget shut-down.

Replies to comments on the petition for rulemaking filed by The Ad Hoc Alliance for public Access to 911 ("Alliance") were due on January 3, 1996. Although the comments on the Alliance's petition were due on a date the Commission was open (December 15th), the Commission shut down immediately thereafter. While the "Alliance" received copies of some comments via service, it does not know if, in fact, it has seen all comments that were filed, since the Commission has not been open since the filing date.
