REPORT ON SETTLEMENT

On February 5, 1996, an Order was released requiring the Wireless Telecommunications Bureau (Bureau) to file a report with respect to the status of the settlement negotiations between the Bureau and Ralph E. Howe. The Bureau has been in contact with Mr. Howe and has sent Mr. Howe a proposed settlement agreement. After discussing the proposed agreement with Mr. Howe, the Bureau sent Mr. Howe by facsimile a final version of the agreement on February 9, 1996. 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
