

ORDER
Issued: April 3, 1996 Released: April 10, 1996

On April 1, 1996, Press Broadcasting Company, Inc. (Press) filed a motion to compel the production of documents by Rainbow Broadcasting Company (RBC). Section 1.325(a)(2) of the Rules specifically provides that "[a] motion to compel must be accompanied by a copy of the original request and the responding party's objection or claim of privilege." Press' motion does not include these documents. This is the second time that Press has failed to comply with the Commission's rules in pursuing its discovery requests. Press is strongly urged to thoroughly familiarize itself with the Commission's Rules before filing any further pleadings. Press will be given until the close of business on April 5, 1996 to refile its motion to compel in accordance with Section 1.325(a)(2) of the Rules. ¹
