Dear Mr. Caton:

Pursuant to Section 1.1206 of the Commission's rules, 47 C.F.R. § 1.1206, I report that Robert H. Turner, President and Chief Executive Officer; Thomas MacLeod, Vice President-Business Development and I, on behalf of EON Corporation, met on Friday, April 26, 1996 with David Siddall, legal advisor to Commissioner Susan Ness. We discussed the issues raised in EON's pleading filed in the above-captioned proceeding regarding the flexible use of interactive video and data services ("IVDS").

Specifically, EON explained that shareholders have invested \$170 million in technology development for the IVDS spectrum. In creating a services operating company, EON is attempting to bring together strategic partners to provide manufacturing, operations and capital support for a nationwide private network.

EON has developed an IVDS platform that can support fixed telemetry applications such as vending machine monitoring and interactive television, and eventually, both fixed and mobile e-mail, including Internet and information services gateways. The EON platform, which supports a private network, conforms in all respects to the operating parameters proposed in the rulemaking. It is EON's strong view that while the IVDS industry remains fragmented and limited to fixed applications it cannot thrive.


