ERRATUM TO COMMENTS OF ITFS PARTIES


Dow, Lohnes and Albertson, on behalf of San Diego County Office of Education, hereby files this Erratum to Comments of ITFS Parties, filed May 3, 1996, on behalf of a number of ITFS Parties. It has come to our attention that the name of one of the ITFS Parties -- San Diego County Office of Education -- was inadvertently omitted from the list of commenting ITFS Parties. The San Diego County Office of Education has an important educational perspective, as it serves 43 school districts, 586 elementary school sites (K-12), and 8 community colleges. In 1993-94, the San Diego County Office of Education served a combined K-12 enrollment of 421,790 students, and a combined faculty of approximately 17,500. Thus, it is important that it be included in the list of commenting ITFS Parties.
