

Dear Jan:

This is a follow-up on our phone call today.

Enclosed is the signed form for Thompson & Mitchell. They can be no worse than Stinson-Mag-Fizzell.

You can incorporate statements made in our FCC filings, such as our claim that Shepherd filed a form of a strike application, at the FCC, and that the phone calls and inquiries were made to mislead me, and for an FCC complaint, etc.

Also, it should be pointed out I knew the two Shepherds for around 20 years, spoke to them at conventions, etc., so it was only convention and courtesy for me to reply.

There also may be some anti-trust action due to competing radio stations meeting to discuss methods of keeping a competitor out of their marketplace.

I also am sure that the Shepherds were well aware that I had serious mental problems, and was hospitalized for an extended period of time, prior to their phone calls, hence, they were aware that my criminal problems were related to my mental problems, and they were aware that all of our stations have been operated in a very professional manner for years.

Please follow up on my typewriter...I really miss it..this one I'm using, is at the library, and not easily available to me.

If this does not happen, and you get more reports of incidents, we will have to change the locks and keep them out of the station.

I'm afraid that if Dennis and Ken continue, we WILL LOSE the present manager.

One way we can keep morale up is to keep purchasing new equipment such as remote gear, promotional items, vans, etc., so that we give an image of progress, not a dead-end station.


