We commend congress in their support of the Telecommunication Act (FCC 95-484.) Closed Captioning and Video description of Video Programming is a benefit to everyone. We are asking that you consider having all programming captioned. It is frustrating when we are excluded from a program in which we have an interest. We do not feel someone else should determine what "CLASS" of program we should be allowed to have access.
