

There was also a ruling by the Presiding Judge on sequestration that was objected to by Liberty. Based on a request of counsel for Time Warner, it was determined that in the interest of obtaining independent recollection of relevant facts, deposition witnesses were to be precluded from disclosing their answers to deposition questions to succeeding fact witnesses. Discussion and argument on the ruling and its scope are on-the-record of the deposition transcript of May 20, 1996. See 47 C.F.R. §1.319 (rulings on objections at depositions).
