By the Chief, Commercial Wireless Division:

1. This erratum corrects Section 90.213 of the Commission's rules, 47 C.F.R. § 90.213, as modified in *Amendment of Part 90 of the Commission's Rules to Adopt Regulations for Automatic Vehicle Monitoring Systems, Order on Reconsideration*, PR Docket No. 93-61, FCC 96-115 (released March 21, 1996), 61 FR 18981 (April 30, 1996).

2. Section 90.213 of the Commission's Rules, 47 C.F.R. § 90.213, is amended by revising footnote 13 to the table in paragraph (a) to read as follows:

§ 90.213 Frequency stability.

(a) * * *

13/ Fixed non-multilateration transmitters with an authorized bandwidth that is more than 40 kHz from the band edge, intermittently operated hand-held readers, and mobile transponders are not subject to frequency stability restrictions.
