O R D E R

Issued: June 6, 1996 ; Released: June 10, 1996

This is a ruling that summarizes action items covered in bench rulings at the first Prehearing Conference in this case that was held on June 6, 1996. See Prehearing Conference Order FCC 96M-106, released May 10, 1996.

The parties have agreed to attempt to reach agreement on the terms and conditions of an appropriate Consent Order under the Commission's Rules §1.93 and §1.94. It was acknowledged on-the-record that there are no questions of basic qualifications in this case. Alternatively, the renewal licensee may proceed by Motion for Summary Decision under Commission's Rule §1.251 in accordance with the schedule set below.

- June 28, 1996 - Status Report submitted to Presiding Judge (preferably joint).
- July 15, 1996 - Proposed Consent Order with supporting Memoranda and Exhibits, or Motion For Summary Decision.
- July 31, 1996 - Comment or Opposition to Motion For Summary Decision.

In light of the agreement to negotiate, it is appropriate to cancel all previously set procedural and hearing dates. See Prehearing Conference Order, supra. Counsel for the renewal licensee was urged to expedite filings with the processing branches to the extent possible and to serve the Bureau's trial counsel with copies. Bureau counsel was urged to cooperate to the extent possible with the expedited procedures contemplated for silent stations that seek to return to the air. (DA 96-818, May 2, 1996).

Accordingly, IT IS ORDERED that the procedural dates set for the exchange of hearing exhibits and the hearing date set for September 17, 1996, ARE CANCELLED.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the parties SHALL COMPLY with the above established procedures.
