MASS MEDIA BUREAU'S COMMENTS ON
MOTION FOR SUMMARY DECISION

1. On May 31 1996, Communications Enterprises, Inc. ("CEI") filed a motion for summary decision in the above captioned proceeding. The Mass Media Bureau hereby supports CEI's motion.


2. CEI's motion is filed pursuant to Section 1.251 of the Commission's Rules. This Section requires, inter alia, that the moving party demonstrate, by supporting affidavit or by other materials subject to consideration by the Presiding Judge, that there is no genuine issue of material fact for determination at the hearing. CEI's motion demonstrates that because the subject station did, in fact, return to full broadcast operation during the period covered by its last-granted special temporary silent authority,¹ no issue warranting hearing on the matter of the station's pending license renewal application, or possible violation of Sections 73.1740

and/or 73.1750 of the Commission Rules, any longer exists. Consequently, the Mass Media Bureau supports CEI's motion and joins in its request that the station's license renewal application be granted, and the instant proceeding terminated. Accordingly, the Presiding Judge should grant CEI's motion for summary decision in the instant case.
