$$50 \times (1.01)^{(6-1)} + 50 \times (1.01)^{(6-2)} + 50 \times (1.01)^{(6-3)} + 50 \times (1.01)^{(6-4)} + 50 \times (1.01)^{(6-5)} + 50 \times (1.01)^{(6-6)} = 52.55 + 52.03 + 51.52 + 51.01 + 50.5 + 50 = 307.61$$

The conversion charge is \$307.61.

Credit for Initial Payments

Customers whose ICB initial nonrecurring charge was greater than the general nonrecurring charge and whose ICB recurring rate was lower than the general recurring rate are eligible to receive a credit for the amount paid in excess of the benefit the customer received from paying the lower ICB recurring rate. Customers eligible for a credit will be informed of the amount within 30 days after the customer either converts to tariffed MegaLink Custom Service or terminates the MegaLink Custom ICB arrangement. 1) Moves

A move involves a change in the physical location of one of the following:

- The Point of Termination of the customer's premises;
- The customer's premises, within the same exchange;
- From one Telephone Company hub to another Telephone Company hub. (C)

The expiration of the new billing period must extend to or beyond the expiration of the original billing period.

The charges are dependant upon the type of move requested by the customer.

A customer may request a move of the Point of Termination of Vintage MegaLink Custom Services (DS3) from one Telephone Company hub to another Telephone Company hub. Facilities and equipment must exist and be available. These moves will be permitted only on shared use facilities. Orders will be accepted beginning September 26, 1994. These regulations will be valid until the expiration date of the waiver of nonrecurring charges associated with the restructure of Local Transport as referenced in Section 6.8.2.(D)(9). (C)

Service extensions for MegaLink Custom Service(s) must be equal to or less than the original number of Customer Designated Premises to Telephone Company Hub Central Office Service(s).

A MegaLink Custom Electrical Service with Loop Redundancy or Serving Wire Center and Facility Redundancy can be extended with a Service Extension. However, the Service Extension cannot be equipped with a SecureNet option.
