Re: CC Docket No. 94-54, CMRS Equal Access and Interconnection

This filing reflects discussions which occurred prior to the Sunshine Period applicable to the above-referenced proceeding. It is being submitted at the request of Commission personnel.

On June 5, Jacqueline Chorney, Special Assistant to Chairman Hundt, and Karen Brinkmann, Associate Chief, Wireless Telecommunications Bureau, spoke with James Tuthill, Vice President, External Affairs and General Counsel, Pacific Bell Mobile Services (PBMS) and Alan Ciamporcero, Vice President, Regulatory, Pacific Telesis; on Tuesday, June 13, James Tuthill and I spoke with Michael Wack, Deputy Chief, Policy Division, Wireless Telecommunications Bureau; and on June 19, James Tuthill and I spoke with Suzanne Toller, Legal Advisor to Commissioner Chong. These discussions took place at the request of the FCC staff and concerned the fact that PBMS had ceased actively urging the Commission to adopt a mandatory roaming rule. PBMS explained that it now believed that agreements would be concluded with other commercial mobile radio service providers which made it unnecessary to continue such advocacy.
