This is to advise you that American Mobilphone, Inc. on April 1, 1996, filed a 402(a) Petition for Review of: In the Matter of Amendment of the Commission's Rules to Provide Channel Exclusivity to Qualified Private Paging Systems at 929-930 MHz, FCC 96-53, PR Docket No. 93-35 and RM-7986, released February 13, 1996.

This case involves a challenge to the Wireless Bureau's determination that the private carrier paging ("PCP") systems grandfathered when new channel exclusivity rules were announced would not be eligible for extended construction periods.

The Court has docketed this case as No. 96-1097 and the attorney assigned to handle the litigation is Susan L. Fox.
