

Today, Thomas Spavins (OGC), James Olson (OGC), Robert Pepper (OPP), and Elliot Maxwell (OPP) met with Mr. Joseph J. Mulieri (Bell Atlantic) and Mr. Randy Kramer (an employee of Bell Atlantic who is a dedicated under contract to the Commission). Mr. Kramer took the group on a tour of the internal telecommunications facilities of the FCC. Mr. Kramer took the group to an interface in a room in the basement of the FCC, and to another interface in a closet on the sixth floor.
