Dear Mr. Caton:

On July 16, 1996, the American Mobile Telecommunications Association, Inc. (AMTA) made an oral ex parte presentation concerning the above-referenced proceedings to Michele Farquhar, Chief of the Wireless Telecommunications Bureau (the "Bureau"). Also present were: Rosalind Allen, Deputy Bureau Chief; David Furth, Chief of the Bureau's Commercial Wireless Division; and David Kirschner of the Commercial Wireless Division.

The meeting consisted of a general discussion concerning the progress of the FCC's work in the above-referenced matters, and the status of the 800 MHz SMR industry coalition that has presented a consensus position to the Commission. The Association also repeated its recommendation that new licensing rules for the 220 MHz service include retention of non-contiguous channel groupings where now allocated.
