THIS CAUSE came before the Court on November 27, 1990 at a Status Conference, and the Court having heard argument of counsel and being otherwise duly advised in the premises, it is thereupon

ORDERED AND ADJUDGED:

1. Defendants have represented to the Court that there have been no agreements or lease entered into by the Defendants and PRESS and/or CHANNEL 18 for the BITHLO TOWER. Defendants have agreed to preserve the status quo between now and the date of the Preliminary Injunction hearing and the Court hereby orders Defendants to preserve said status quo and to not sign or consummate any agreement or lease with PRESS and/or CHANNEL 18 between the date of this hearing and the date of the Preliminary

Injunction hearing. This eliminates the need for the Court to rule on Plaintiffs' Motion for Temporary Restraining Order.

2. A hearing on Plaintiffs' Motion for Preliminary Injunction be and is hereby set for Thursday, December 20, 1990 at 1:00 p.m. The time reserved for said hearing is four (4) hours.

3. The parties are to confer and work together to expedite discovery prior to the Preliminary Injunction Hearing.

4. The parties be and are hereby ordered to submit briefs on the issues pertaining to the Preliminary Injunction at least twenty-four (24) hours before the date of the hearing on the Preliminary Injunction.

5. Defendants be and are hereby ordered to file an Answer to the Complaint by or on before December 3, 1990.

6. The Status Conference previously set by this Court for December 14, 1990 be and is hereby CANCELLED.
