ORDER

By the Chief, Mass Media Bureau:

1. This proceeding began on March 19, 1996, when the Mass Media Bureau, by delegated authority, released an Order to Show Cause and Hearing Designation Order, DA 96-338 ("HDO"). The HDO directed Rainy River Community College ("Rainy River") to show cause why its license to operate radio Station KICC(FM), International Falls, Minnesota, should not be revoked. The HDO also constituted a Notice of Apparent Liability for Forfeiture to provide the Commission with the fullest possibility of action in this proceeding.

2. The HDO specified issues to determine whether Rainy River had the capability to expeditiously resume broadcast operations of KICC(FM); to determine whether Rainy River had violated Sections 73.561(d) (Notification of Discontinuance of Operation) and 73.1750 (Discontinuance of Operation) of the Commission's Rules; and to determine, based on the evidence adduced pursuant to the foregoing issues, whether Rainy River is qualified to be and remain the licensee of KICC(FM).

3. By Memorandum and Opinion Order, FCC 96M-90 (released May 1, 1996), the Presiding Judge terminated the hearing proceeding and, pursuant to Section 1.91(c) of the Commission's Rules, certified the case to the Commission. The Presiding Judge did so based on the fact that Rainy River failed to file the required notice of appearance; instead by letter dated April 3, 1996, it had requested that its license be revoked.

4. As a consequence of Rainy River's voluntary action relinquishing the KICC(FM)

license, we grant its requested relief.


5. ACCORDINGLY, IT IS ORDERED, That the authority of Rainy River Community College to operate Station KICC(FM), International Falls, Minnesota is hereby REVOKED.¹

6. IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, That the call sign for Station KICC(FM) is hereby DELETED.

7. IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, That this proceeding IS TERMINATED.

8. IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, That a copy of this Order shall be sent by Certified Mail - Return Receipt Requested to Rainy River Community College.
