Pursuant to Section 1.1206 of the Commission's rules and regulations, Motorola, Inc. hereby reports that on July 23, 1996, Michael D. Kennedy of Motorola, Inc. met with Donald Gips, Karen Kornbluh and Kim Malone of the International Bureau concerning the above-referenced proceedings.

The discussion regarding IB Docket No. 96-111 dealt with matters addressed in the comments filed by Motorola in response to the Commission's Notice of Proposed Rulemaking in that proceeding.

The discussion regarding ET Docket No. 95-183 dealt with issues raised in Motorola's petition for rulemaking (RM No. 8811) seeking the domestic implementation of the global Fixed Satellite Service allocation in the 37.5-38.6 GHz band as well as the existence of shared government allocations in the 37.0-40.0 GHz range. An original and one copy of this letter are being submitted for inclusion in the record of each of the above-referenced proceedings.


