

On Friday, July 19, William Kennard, General Counsel and David Solomon, Deputy General Counsel, called me to discuss the relationship between Sections 251-252 and Section 332 of the Communications Act as they could affect jurisdiction over Commercial Mobile Radio/Local Exchange Company Interconnection. I expressed the view, on behalf of the Cellular Telecommunications Industry Association, that Section 332 afforded exclusive, or at a minimum concurrent, jurisdiction over CMRS/LEC interconnection.
