
Dear Mr. Caton:

Pursuant to § 1.1206 of the Commission's rules, 47 C.F.R. § 1.1206, this is to inform you that on August 6, 1996, representatives of ICO Global Communications, Kumar Singarajah and Robert Phillips, and the undersigned met with the International Bureau representatives, Tom Tycz, Damon Ladson, Harry Eng, Virginia Marshall and Karl Kensinger regarding the above-captioned proceedings. Specifically, we discussed the applicability of the Commission's rules regarding the relocation of microwave facilities to mobile satellite services. In addition, ICO discussed the Commission's proposed ECO-Sat test for non-U.S.-licensed satellite systems. ICO restricted its comments to those contained in its Joint Comments of the MSS Coalition filed in ET Docket 95-18 on May 17, 1996, and its comments filed in IB Docket No. 96-111, et seq. on July 15, 1996.
