Thank you for your inquiry on behalf of Mr. W. Cornwell Stone, President of Chester Broadcasting Company, Inc., licensee of radio station WGCD(AM), Chester, South Carolina. You requested that the Commission consider the difficult circumstances surrounding the licensee's attempts to sell the station before acting on its October 5, 1994 request to remain silent. Our records indicate that the Commission mailed a response to that request on October 25, 1994, extending WGCD's authority to remain off-the-air until January 25, 1995. Because of the likelihood that our response and your inquiry letter crossed in the mail we are enclosing a copy of our October 25, 1994 response.

This letter concerns your pending request for authority to remain silent. Temporary authority is hereby granted for the above-referenced station(s) to remain silent for three months from the date of this letter.



Dear Mr. Burtle:

On or about July 19, 1994, the Federal Communications Commission granted permission for radio station WGCD located in Chester, South Carolina, to remain silent until October 19, 1994. Although many efforts have been made to return the station to the air, we have been unable to do so as of this date; therefore, we respectfully request permission to remain silent until January, 1995, in order that we can effectuate the transfer of ownership of this station to a purchaser which we hope will be approved by the Federal Communications Commission. Since radio station WGCD is the only locally owned radio station in Chester County, we feel that it would be in the best interest of Chester County that this station resume its operations and provide a vital service to this community.

Since the extension granted to us in July, 1994, we have worked diligently to obtain a purchaser for the radio station. In fact, we were under the impression that we had a bonafide purchaser in August, 1994, and pursuant to an oral agreement a preliminary agreement was reduce to writing wherein it was agreed that Audrey F. Murphy, d/b/a AFM Production, Inc. would purchase Chester Broadcasting Company, Inc., and radio station WGCD pending approval by the Federal Communications Commission. I enclose herewith a copy of the Preliminary Agreement for your consideration. Mr. Murphy assured us that he had the appropriate financing for the purchase and that all that remained before the execution and signing of the Preliminary Agreement was the review of the same by his attorney. On or about September 16, 1994, Mr. Murphy, for the first time, indicated that he was having some difficulty with his financing. Mr. Murphy has continued to negotiate with us, however, as of this date he has not signed and executed the agreement. Since September 16, 1994, we have been contacted by Mr. Jack Nicholson from Pageland, South Carolina, on several occasions and

we are presently in the process of negotiating with him for sell of the radio station. Mr. Nicholson appears to have some experience in the operation of a radio station and we consider him to be a legitimate prospective purchaser.

In addition to the other interested parties which I outlined to you in my previous letters, we have recently been contacted by Mr. Harold Burnell of Charlotte, North Carolina, who has also expressed an interest in purchasing the station. I have been out of my office on several occasions during the month of September, 1994, however, I hope that we will be hearing from Mr. Burnell in the near future.

We believe we have made substantial progress in our efforts to obtain a purchaser for the station since our extension was granted in July, 1994. We are also in the process of meeting with our attorney to finalize a payment plan to the creditors of the corporation in order that we may return the station to the air ourselves in the event we are unable to sell the station.

We respectfully request that the Federal Communications Commission grant us permission for radio station WGCD, located in Chester, South Carolina, to remain silent until January, 1995. As I previously advised you, Chester Broadcasting Company, Inc. is a locally owned corporation and the stock is owned by two (2) other Chester County residents and myself and none of us are familiar with the operation of a radio station. Since the station manager abruptly resigned in June, 1993, and left the station in poor financial condition, we have made every effort within our power to sell the station and/or return it to the air. We believe that some of the delay in selling the station and/or returning it to the air has been a result of our lack of knowledge for the radio business. However, we assure you that we have been operating in good faith and it finally appears that we have a management consultant who can return the station to the air in a short period of time if we are granted the extension. If you would like any further information concerning this matter, please do not hesitate to call me.

I also enclose an Anti Drug Abuse Act certification which has been duly signed and executed for your consideration.

Question-by-Question Guidelines (FCC Form 303-S)

1. The name of the applicant should be stated exactly as it appears on the station's existing license. The current street address or post office box used by the applicant for receipt of Commission correspondence should be set forth.
2. Every station with five or more full-time employees must file an employment report on or before May 31 of each year. That report is to be available locally for public inspection.
A current and complete ownership report should be submitted with the licensee's renewal application and the question answered affirmatively. However, if the ownership report submitted with a station's last renewal application is "up-to-date" and has not been amended, a new report need not be filed with the current renewal application. The applicant should answer the question negatively and should supply the call letters of the station and the filing date of the renewal application with which the ownership report was submitted. An "up-to-date" ownership report is one that is current for each question on that report.
3. Aliens, foreign governments and corporations, and corporations of which any officer or director is an alien or of which less than 80% of the capital stock is owned or voted by U.S. citizens, are prohibited from holding a broadcast station license. Where a corporate licensee is directly or indirectly controlled by another corporation, of which any officer or more than 25% of the directors are aliens or of which less than 75% of that corporation's stock is owned or voted by U.S. citizens, the Commission must consider whether denial of renewal would serve the public interest. Licensees are expected to employ reasonable, good faith methods to ensure the accuracy and completeness of their citizenship representations.
4. This question is limited to adverse actions and judgments adjudicated or entered into within the preceding license term. Reportable activities consist of judgments or decrees, including settlement, consent, and like agreements, where the misconduct occurred either in the operation of the station for which renewal is requested or in the conduct of the other broadcast and non-broadcast activities of the renewal applicant and parties to that application, such as all partners and all corporate officers, directors, and stockholders with a 10% or more ownership interest in the applicant.
5. A licensee must maintain certain documents pertaining to its station in a file which should be kept at the station's main studio or other accessible place in the community of license.
