**1. General (Cont'd)**

**1.11 Options Available on the Expiration of the Initial or Renewal Service Term for the SmartTrunk Interface**

Upon the expiration of the 12, 24, 36, 48 or 60 Initial or Renewal Service Term for the SmartTrunk Interface the customer may:

- 1.11.1 Continue service at the Month-to-Month service term rate. That rate will be subject to change.
- 1.11.2 Continue service by selecting a Renewal Service Term for SmartTrunk Interface at the then current rate and pursuant to Footnote No. 14 on Sheet 7, Section 2 of the Integrated Services Tariff. The Renewal Service Term will begin the day following the expiration of the previous service term. The SmartTrunk Interface rate for the Renewal Service Term will not be subject to rate changes made during the duration of the Renewal Service Term. The customer will be required to sign a new contract (as shown in Section 24, Sheet 7 of the General Exchange Tariff) for the service term selected.
- 1.11.3 Disconnect service.

**1.12 Distance Learning**

Upon submission of an affidavit that complies with the requirements of Public Utility Commission of Texas Substantive Rule §23.93, 16 T.A.C. 23.93, an educational institution (as defined in Texas Education Code, Sections 11.32, 11.33 and 61.003), library (as defined in Section 441.122 of the Government Code) or a library operated by an institution of higher education or school district may obtain a 25% discount on the tariff rate for any tariffed service, except customer-specific contracts, that is used predominantly for distance learning purposes. Services qualifying under the provisions of Substantive Rule §23.93 will receive the 25% discount on each tariffed rate, with each such discounted rate being rounded to the nearest one cent.

**2. Rate Applications**

**2.1 Rate Stability for SmartTrunk Interface**

The SmartTrunk Interface monthly rate will not be subject to rate changes for the duration of either the 12, 24, 36, 48 or 60 month Initial or Renewal Service Term selected by the customer.

**2.2 Optional Deferred Payment of Service Connection Charges, Installation Charges and/or Special Construction Charge Available Only for Customers Selecting Either the 12, 24, 36, 48 or 60 Month Initial or Renewal Service Term.**

2.2.1 Before service is established, the customer may request to spread all the service connection charges, installation charges (including the installation charges associated with optional features) and/or special construction charge over a payment term of either 12, 24, 36, 48 or 60 continuous months but not to exceed the 12, 24, 36, 48 or 60 month Initial Service Term. The customer cannot change the deferred payment term. The deferred payment monthly charge will equal the service connection charges, installation charges and/or special construction charge multiplied by the appropriate annuity factor shown below:

Upon 30-days prior notification to SWBT, the customer may terminate the deferred payment term by paying the remaining principal in full. No credit will be made for interest already paid to accrued.

2.2.2 This optional deferred payment is not offered for customers selecting the Month-to-Month service term.

#### 2.3 Disconnection of Service Prior to the Expiration of the Initial or Renewal Service Term

2.3.1 If the customer disconnects a SmartTrunk Interface prior to the expiration of the 12, 24, 36, 48 or 60 month Initial or Renewal Service Term, the customer shall pay a charge equal to the SmartTrunk Interface monthly rate in effect on the date of the contract, times the number of months remaining on the 12, 24, 36, 48 or 60 month Initial or Renewal Service Term for each SmartTrunk Interface disconnected.

2.3.2 If the customer disconnects a SmartTrunk Interface prior to the expiration of the 12, 24, 36, 48 or 60 month Initial Service Term and the installation charge and/or special construction charge were deferred at the time service was established (pursuant to Paragraph 2.2.1 above), the customer shall pay a charge equal to the deferred payment monthly charge, times the number of months remaining on the deferred payment term for each SmartTrunk Interface disconnected.

#### 2.4 Cancellation and Changes in Service Request

Subsequent to signing the contract:

2.4.1 If the customer cancels or changes an order for service after installation of the required equipment and facilities, but before service is established, the customer agrees to pay up front the applicable installation charges specified in 2.7, following and/or the applicable special construction charge if any. The customer may not avoid this provision by extending the service establishment due date. The customer may not defer payment of the installation charge and/or special construction charge.

2.4.2 If the customer cancels an order for service before installation of the required equipment and facilities, the customer agrees to pay Service Connection Charges (under Section 27 of the General Exchange Tariff) which would have been applicable had the service been installed.

#### 2.5 FX, FSO and TIE Services Billing Procedures

2.5.1 FX, FSO and TIE services will be billed in quantities as specified by the customer.

#### 2.6 DID and DOD Services Billing Procedures

2.6.1 If Dynamic Channel Allocation is not provided, DID and DOD services will be billed in quantities as specified by the customer.

2.6.2 If Dynamic Channel Allocation is provided, DID and DOD services will be billed in quantities equal to the total number of channels activated by the customer minus the sum of the channels used for FX, FSO and TIE services.

- {1} Service Connection Charges apply per Section 27 of the General Exchange Tariff.
- {2} Rates are in addition to those specified for DID, FX, FSO and TIE services in other tariffs of SWBT.
- {3} The additional installation charge applies only when an additional SI is ordered and installed with the first SI on the same service request, same SmartTrunk serving central office, same installation date and for the same customer.
- {4} Integrated Services Network Component is not applicable with FX or TIE Services.
- {5} Only the Integrated Services Network Components which are SmartTrunk Service Compatible can be associated with SmartTrunk Service. For rates see Section 1 of the Integrated Services Tariff.
- {6} Universal Termination is not applicable for those FSO and FX service arrangements described in paragraph 1.7.6, Section 2 of the Integrated Services Tariff. (D)
- {7} The additional installation charge applies only when an additional Universal Termination is installed with the first Universal Termination on the same service request, same SmartTrunk serving office, same installation date for the same customer. (T)
- {8} Offered only in central offices equipped with compatible switches capable of providing these features.
- {9} Dynamic Channel Allocation is not available with FSO, FX, TIE services. Dynamic Channel Allocation is not available when DID and DOD services are furnished from both extended and non-extended local service areas using the same SmartTrunk Interface. (C)
- {10} This rate applies per group of five SIs, or fraction thereof, supported by the Backup D-Channel. (C)
- {11} This rate applies only to changes subsequent to the installation of the Dynamic Channel Allocation. (T)

- {13} Payment of service connection charges and installation charges may be spread pursuant to paragraph 2.2 above or pursuant to "-- Installment billing for business customers ...", Sheet 10, Section 23 of the General Exchange Tariff. (N)
- {14} Renewal rates apply only after completion of the Initial Service Term and payment of nonrecurring charges associated with the Initial Service Term. The Renewal Service Terms available depend on the Initial Service Term selected as follows:

#### 7. PBX - DID/AIOD Service

#### 7.1 Central Office Portion of Direct Inward Dialing (DID) Service to Customer-Premises Located Switching Systems

##### 7.1.1 Additional General Regulations

- (A) DID service to customer-premises located switching systems is furnished subject to the availability of facilities and the availability of telephone numbers and appropriate equipment being provided in the customer-premises equipment.
- (B) The service includes the central office switching equipment necessary for DID from the exchange and long distance message telecommunications network directly to stations and attendant positions associated with customer-premises located switching systems.
- (C) The service must be provided on all lines in a trunk or network access line group arranged for inward service. Routing of calls to selected numbers within the DID number group over a separate trunk or network access line group is not contemplated.
- (D) The charges for the service as provided in 7.1.2, following, are in addition to all applicable charges for Private Branch Exchange (PBX) service with which this service is associated or the applicable network access line and connecting arrangement charges as provided in Section 8 of this tariff.
- (E) Operational characteristics of interface signals between SWBT-provided connecting arrangements and the customer-provided switching equipment must conform to the regulations SWBT considers necessary to maintain proper standards of service.
- (F) SWBT shall not be responsible to the customer or authorized user or joint user if changes in protection criteria or in any of the facilities, operations or procedures of SWBT render any facilities provided by a customer, authorized user or joint user obsolete or require modifications or alteration of such equipment or system or otherwise affect its use or performance.
- (G) Directory listings will be provided in accordance with the regulations of Section 12 of this tariff for PBX listed number trunks. DID numbers furnished herein are not entitled to free directory listings.
- (H) The customer-premises located switching equipment must be arranged to provide for intercepting of unused numbers transmitted to the switching equipment.
- (I) The rates and charges for the service contemplate the use of standard SWBT equipment and serving arrangements.

7. PBX - DID/AIOD Service (Cont'd)

7.1 Central Office Portion of DID Service to Customer-Premises Located Switching Systems (Cont'd)

7.1.1 Additional General Regulations (Cont'd)

- (J) If a customer discontinues Centrex service and immediately subscribes to DID service which uses the same central office equipment, installation charges are applicable only to those DID numbers which exceed the quantity of numbers working with the Centrex service.
- (K) DID telephone numbers are normally provided on a consecutive number basis. DID numbers may be provided on a nonconsecutive basis when such service provision is acceptable to the customer and SWBT and, is within the normal limitations of the serving office. SWBT retains its rights to the administration and use of telephone numbers as described in Section 23 of this tariff.
- (L) Note that special steps are required for DID customers to have 911 service features consistent with those provided to other end users in the same 911 service area. Automatic Number Identification, Automatic Location Identification and/or Selective Routing are only available through coordination with the governmental agency responsible for 911 service within the area served by the private switch in accordance with the provisions of Section 6 of the Private Line Service Tariff.
- (M) Customer rearrangements of a block of 100 numbers into one or more blocks of 10 numbers, or vice versa, will constitute a disconnection of the original block of numbers. The new block(s) of DID numbers requested will be considered a new connection and may be comprised of different numbers from those in the disconnected original block(s) of numbers.
- (N) DID numbers are available to customers in two different categories: (1) quantity of 100 or less, and (2) quantities greater than 100. Customers may request the first 100 DID numbers at the quantities, rates and charges specified in 7.1.2, following, listed under Category 1. The customer will be limited to a maximum of nine blocks of 10 DID numbers (USOC NDA) under this category. When more than 100 DID numbers are requested, the rates and charges specified under Category 2 will apply.

#### 7.2 Central Office Portion of Automatic Identified Outward Dialing (AIOD) Service from Customer-Premises Located Switching Systems

##### 7.2.1 Additional General Regulations

- (A) AIOD service from customer-premises located switching systems is furnished subject to equipment and facility limitations and the availability of telephone numbers and appropriate equipment being provided in the customer-premises equipment.
- (B) The service includes the central office equipment necessary for identification of outgoing long distance message telecommunications service (LDMTS) messages and the billing of these messages by station number.
- (C) The service is normally provided on calls placed over PBX trunks or network access lines from the local serving central office. Where AIOD is not available in the customer's local serving central office, it may be provided from a distant serving central office subject to the availability of facilities. In such a case, the PBX trunks or network access lines, over which outward calling takes place, must be served from the AIOD serving office; and tariff charges for foreign central office, foreign zone or foreign exchange trunks are applicable. In addition, Type 313B interoffice channels and/or interexchange channels as provided in Section 2 of the Private Line Service Tariff, are applicable for the required Data link.
- (D) The service must be provided on all lines in a trunk or network access line group. Where the service is requested and provided on more than one trunk or network access line group, each such group will be considered a separate service in determining charges.
- (E) The charges for the service as provided in 7.2.2, following, are in addition to all applicable charges for PBX service with which this service is associated or the applicable network access line and connecting arrangement charges as provided in Section 8 of this tariff.
- (F) Operational characteristics of interface signals between SWBT-provided connecting arrangements and the customer-provided communications system with switching equipment must conform to the regulations SWBT considers necessary to maintain proper standards of service.
- (G) SWBT shall not be responsible to the customer or authorized user or joint user if changes in protection criteria or in any of the facilities, operations or procedures of SWBT, render any facilities provided by a customer, authorized user or joint user obsolete or require modification or alteration of such equipment or system or otherwise affect its use or performance.
- (H) The rates and charges for the service contemplate the use of standard SWBT equipment and serving arrangements.


