Jim Hollansworth has, at our request, volunteered to serve on a panel of satellite experts to evaluate three pioneer's preference requests made by applicants for digital audio radio services (DARS) licenses. We had originally spoken to Dave Struba about his participation but due to scheduling conflicts, he suggested that Jim participate instead. We write to express our appreciation to Jim and to you for accommodating our request and assisting the Commission by having Jim perform this critical review.

Under separate cover we will send Jim the materials submitted by the applicants for review, along with materials that set forth the relevant criteria for review. We are asking that each panelist submit to us, on or before September 16, a written recommendation whether each application merits a pioneer's preference, according to the relevant criteria. Each panelist will work independently on their evaluations at their own offices and will not be detailed to the Commission. The materials we will forward are not voluminous and we are confident that careful review and evaluation can be completed by September 16, even taking into account panelists' vacation schedules and other professional responsibilities.

Pat Carney in the Commission's Office of General Counsel is in the process of contacting all of the panelists to ensure that there are no conflicts of interest that would bar any individual's participation.
