("AWS"), Candy Castle, Director-External Affairs, and I met yesterday with Robert Cleveland, Jr. and Richard Engelman of the Office of Engineering and Technology and today with David Wye of the Wireless Telecommunications Bureau. At both meetings we discussed the points raised in AWS' petition for reconsideration in the above-referenced docket and, in particular, urged the Commission to consider delaying the effective date of the rules until one year from the date that a revised version of OET Bulletin 65 is released. This proposal would give the industry the time needed to develop assessment and compliance programs that conform with OET Bulletin 65.
