IT IS ORDERED, That Administrative Law Judge Arthur I. IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, That the following procedures SHALL GOVERN this case:

By October 18, 1996, the parties SHALL MEET to discuss the possibility of settling this case. <sup>2</sup> As part of these discussions, the parties, after taking into consideration the various Commission rulings in the Designation Order, SHALL IDENTIFY, with particularity, all areas of disagreement with respect to the components and figures used in the conduit attachment formulas set forth in the Designation Order.

By October 28, 1996, the parties SHALL FILE a comprehensive Joint Report stating the prospects of settling this case. If the case has not been settled, the parties, in their Joint Report, SHALL IDENTIFY with particularity the exact nature of the remaining disagreements with respect to the various component parts of the conduit attachment formulas.

By November 8, 1996, the parties, individually, SHALL FILE a brief, not in excess of 10 pages, supporting its position with respect to the accuracy and validity of the component parts of the conduit attachment formulas to which there is disagreement. Appropriate legal and factual citations SHALL BE INCLUDED. In addition, with respect to each disputed figure or fact, each party SHALL IDENTIFY the witness or witnesses able to support their contention, including their names, addresses, and positions.

All parties are put on notice that they are expected to be fully cognizant of Part 1 of the Commission's Rules and Regulations concerning Practice and Procedure.
