Attached is TIA's two slide presentation to the FCC at the meeting.



Proposed FCC Part 68 MLTS Registration Requirements

- **New Designs (2-3 years)**
 - » three-digit 9-1-1 dialing with fast routing
 - » attendant notification capability
 - » installation instructions (allow adjuncts)
 - » applicable interface requirements - standards
- **Existing Designs**
 - » "grandfather"
 - » installation instructions (allow adjuncts)
 - » applicable interface requirements - standards

Proposed FCC Part 64 (Miscellaneous Rules) Additions

- **Call Aggregators Responsibilities ***
 - » installation certification
